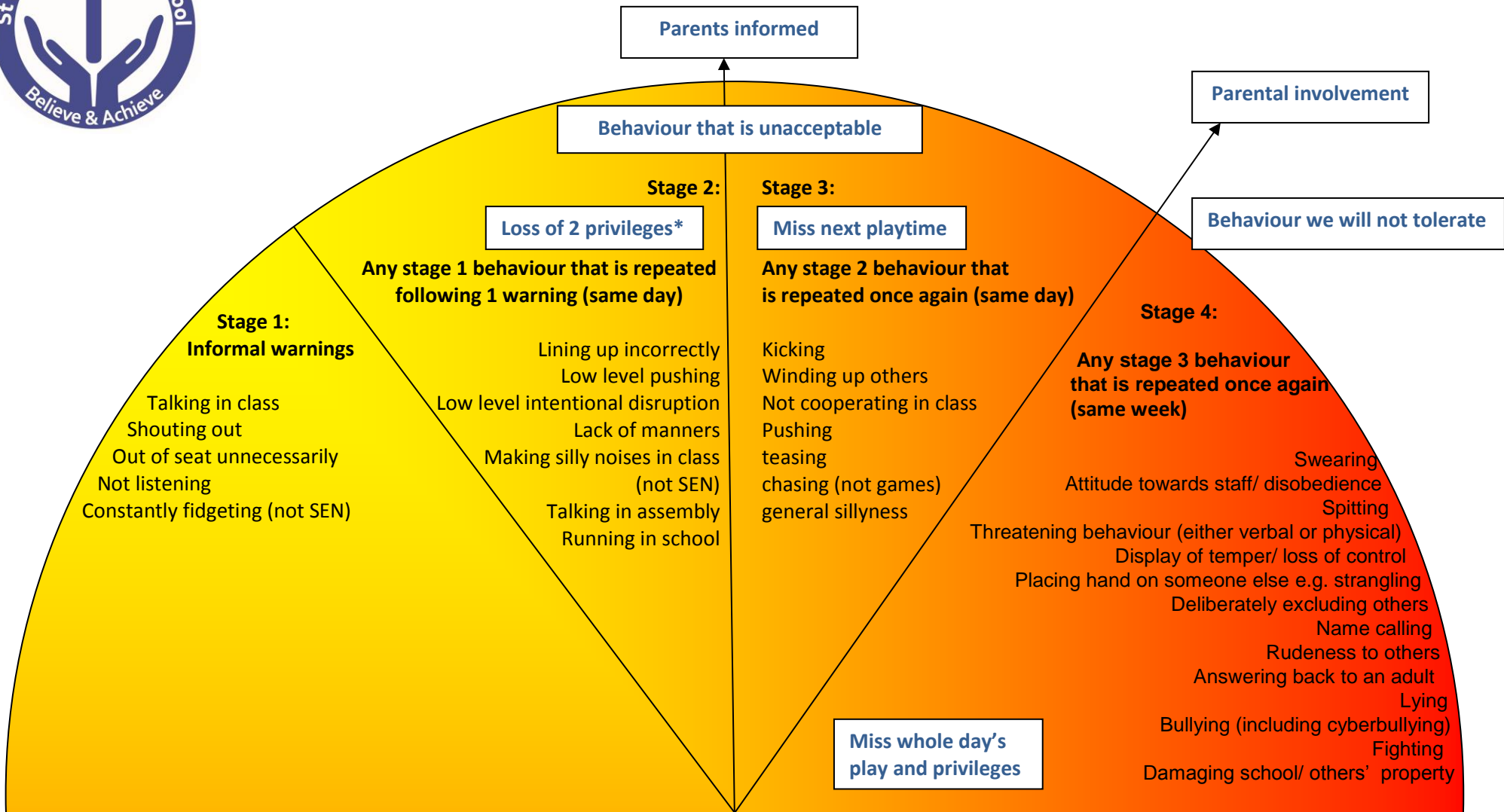




# Behaviour structure chart – St. Luke’s Christian ethos underpins all of its policy and practice



If stage 4 is repeated – Positive handing plan completed. Behaviour and success book implemented (kept by class teacher). Other agency intervention sought. If all else fails: - child deemed to be at risk of exclusion.

Loss of privileges\*: Stage 2 & 4: Playground activities, adventure playground, school jobs, school clubs, representing school etc.  
Repeated Stage 4: End of half term treat, school trips, arranged activities etc.

We embed our core Christian Values into our behaviour structure: LOVE, TRUST, RESPECT, FORGIVENESS, FRIENDSHIP AND PATIENCE.
