**Please can we remind you about our expectations for uniform and conduct on the school grounds**

Black school shoes, **no trainers**

**Outdoor kit needed for children from Year 2 through to Year 6**

**No** chewing gum

Bikes-children must wear a helmet riding to school, they must not ride their bike or scooter on the school grounds

Dogs are not permitted on the school grounds

Mobile phones should only be brought by children walking to school on their own. They must be handed into the school office in the morning and collected at the end of the day.
