



We are donating £100 to St Luke's Church.






Years 3, 4, 5 & 6 walked to St Luke's Church for their Christingle service. It was lovely to see so many families coming to support their children.

Thank you to all who bought raffle tickets.


St Luke's CE Primary School

<u>Free School Meal Forms</u>

If you receive any of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

All children in Reception, Year 1 & 2 receive Universal Free School Meals but if you receive any of the above, you need to apply. If successful you could receive vouchers during the February half term holidays.

School Grid (Dolce) – School Meals

Please check your Food & School Account on School Grid. All arrears <u>must</u> <u>be</u> cleared before the end of this half term.

NB: Dinner Money must be paid in advance on your School Grid Account.

School dinners are £2.46 per day, £12.30 per week.

If your account is in arrears of £5 or more, your account will be frozen & Dolce will not authorise your child's meal. Please check your child's account weekly. If possible, please order your child's meal at home.


