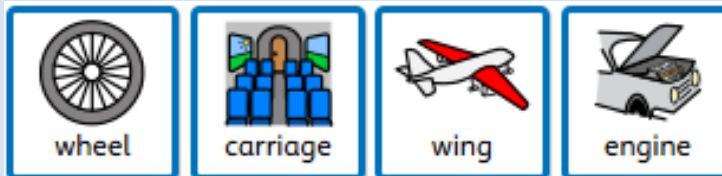


Things I will learn

Understanding the world:

Children in Reception will be learning to:

- Draw information from a simple map.
- Recognise some similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries.
- Recognise some environments that are different from the one in which they live.
- Describe what they see, hear and feel whilst outside.
- Explore how different materials sink and float.
- Draw children's attention to forces.
- Play with and investigate wind-up toys and pulleys.
- Introduce a range of occupations, such as a plumber, a farmer, a vet, a member of the emergency services or an author.
